

## Supply List for Goerlich Mini-Workshop

## All participants to bring:

- **SEWING MACHINE**: It doesn't need to be a fancy machine (mine is a 40+ year-old Kenmore!) but if it **has a zig-zag feature** that would help. It's preferable (but not mandatory) to be able to **drop the feed dogs**. PLEASE BE SURE TO HAVE A WORKING KNOWLEDGE OF YOUR MACHINE AND BE SURE IT IS IN GOOD WORKING ORDER! (Susan can trouble-shoot some mechanical machines but not computerized machines). <u>Don't forget the power cord and instruction manual</u>
- Long Extension cord (15-20' is good)
- Empty bobbins (5-10)
- Extra sewing machine needles (in case needles break, which happens often in the beginning). Size 70 general purpose needles are good.
- Threads- in a variety of colors that are appropriate for flowers, fish, butterflies, leaves, etc. (regular sewing thread). I will have a supply of threads but some machines are very fussy about thread type.
- Glasses /Eye protection (to protect you from those breaking needles).
- Embroidery scissors or snippers
- **Fabric:** OPTIONAL light blue and/or light green (3/8 yard or more) to serve as backgrounds for gardens/landscapes/underwater scenes. (You do not need to pre-wash fabric)
- Notebook, pen and pencil
- Tweezers
- Small screwdriver (for making adjustments on your sewing machine)
- Small brush (for cleaning threads out of sewing machine)
- · A light or lamp if you would like
