thread. Huge crochet or knitting needles if you wish to add crochet or knitting. One wide-notch cardboard weaving board per student. Things to mold the Fosshape over, such as hat blocks. Assortment of spray paint formulated for plastic, and a large cardboard box to contain spraying. Dye-na-flow fabric paint, acrylic paints, paintbrushes, containers for water, and a simple paint palette. Sewing machine optional.
