

Extended Workshop Supply List

Materials to gather within your home:

Assortment of laces, fabric scraps, ribbons, beads, bobbles, threads
Cardboard
Cutting board that you don't mind making holes into
Glass head common pins for pin looms
Small box and duct tape for box looms (approx. 5x7 to 6x8 in)
Cardboard from and old box
Bamboo skewer
Crochet hooks for small stitching
Favorites from their stash of threads, yarns, beads, fabrics etc
Needles for sewing and embroidery
Scissors
Sewing supplies like thimble, tape measure, pins etc.
Old buttons
Old costume jewelry
Sketchpad and pencil
Wire cutters and needlenose pliers
Found objects like bottle caps, old keys, rusty nails, doll furniture, patches, costume jewelry and whatever else you find on nature walks or at the bottom of your junk drawers!

Awl, Dremel drill or hammer and nail to perforate a hole
Popsicle stick or two
Toilet Paper cardboard tube
Strong small bull dog clip (office supply)

Items to prepurchase:

Seed beads (any size 9-11)
Plastic rings for curtains, assorted sizes
Beading needle
Weaving needle (long with blunt tip) or Tapestry needle (with blunt tip)
Small amount of white glue or acrylic medium

Copper jewelry wire, 22 gauge round, medium spool approx.. 150 feet or more <https://parawire.com/shop-by-color/>
