Student Supply List:

- scissors (used for paper/fabric)
- pencil
- metal ruler (12" minimum) One like this is perfect: https://www.dickblick.com/products/blick-stainless-steel-ruler/
- 12x18 inch self-healing cutting mat. Larger size is fine too. This should not be your "good" cutting mat. We are going to get some methyl cellulose and possibly acrylic paint on it, which should wash off easily, but choose one you don't mind getting a little messy.
- 2-3 cans of soup/veggies from your cupboard. We will use these as book weights. They can go back in the cupboard when you are done.

- A catalog or magazine from your recycling bin. We are going to use this as waste paper to catch extra glue when making our book covers. It should be something you don't want to keep.
- Scrap fabric for your book cover. Minimum 14 x 12 inches. Lightweight quilting cotton, batiks & lawn work really well. I recommend a solid, semi solid, monochrome, or similar relatively low volume print. We are going to embroider on it and want that embroidery to show up. If you are unsure, bring a couple of options.
- 2 small containers for paint & glue (ie recycled yogurt cups, take out containers)
- an exacto knife or utility knife with a new sharp blade (If you don't have one, please don't purchase one especially for this class. You can absolutely share with a friend. We only need it for a few cuts.)
