Recommended <u>vendor</u> by instructor. Choose the color in the size of 8x10 inch leather sheet with a suggested amount of 2 to 4 8x10in sheets of leather. How much leather you use will depend on the boot design you choose in class.

The instructor recommends the student mentioned to the seller at time of order that the thickness of leather should not be more than 1,2 mm. He is very easy to work with.
